### Day 1 Arrival Vancouver

Meet and Greet by tour guide. Private transfer to selected hotel for registration.

1-Night Hotel Accommodation in Vancouver: Coast Vancouver Airport Hotel or similar

### Day 2 Vancouver – Kamloops – Golden

Seat-in-coach travel through the rich farmland of Fraser Valley to Kamloops. Visit Ginseng Farm where you can learn about the cultivation process of ginseng and the varieties of American Ginseng. We continue towards Last Spike Historic Site, which was the ceremonial final spike driven into the Canadian Pacific Railway at Craigellachie, Columbia at 9:22 am on November 7, 1885. We also stop by Three Valley Gap, Glacier National Park & Roger's Pass.

### DAY 3 Golden – Bow Lake – Columbia Icefield (Ice Explorer & Glacier Skywalk) – Banff- Lake Louise



Drive along Icefields Parkway to Columbia Icefields. On the way stop at Bow Lake for a short break. Visit Columbia Icefield Center where you can choose **optional** Ice Explorer ride and Glacier Skywalk to discover the power of nature on the Glacier Adventure – the must-do experience in the Canadian Rockies. We will continue towards Banff National Park and visit Bow Falls which were made famous by Marilyn Monroe in the River of No Return. Explore Banff Town where you can stroll on the street and

enjoy the beautiful view of Canadian Rockies, as well as shop at its specialty stores. Transportation to Lake Louise and stay at Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise

1-Night Hotel Accommodation in Lake Louise: Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise

### DAY 4 Lake Louise – Vernon / Salmon Arm

Explore Lake Louise which is a hamlet in Banff National Park in the Canadian Rockies, known for its turquoise, glacier-fed lake ringed by high peaks and overlooked by a stately chateau. Afternoon transportation to Vernon and registration in the selected hotel.

## **DAY 5 Vernon / Salmon Arm – Kelowna - Lake Okanagan - Vancouver**

Visit Honey Bee Farm. The beekeeper will educate you on how to process honey, how long honey bees live for and etc. We continue to a winery farm where you can learn the process of local wine. Explore Lake Okanagan where monster watchers claimed sightings of Ogopogo. Transportation to selected hotel in Vancouver.

## **Day 6 Vancouver – City Tour**

Bonus!! Exclusive scenic mini ferry (admission Included) between False Creek and Granville Island. The rich artistic culture marked this trending hot spot as one of the must-go place in Vancouver. Vancouver sightseeing tour follows the footsteps of the Chinese heritage by visiting the Chinatown, where you find the shallowest commercial building in the world, Sam Kee Building. Then, explore the Gastown, the oldest neighborhood. Catch the Steam Clock whistles. Afterward, visit the downtown landmarks including the Canada Place, Vancouver Convention Center and the Olympic Cauldron. Then, visit Stanley Park, Vancouver's first, largest, and most beloved urban park. Explore the 400-hectare natural West Coast rainforest and enjoy scenic views of water, mountains, sky, and majestic trees along Stanley Park's famous Seawall. Step on the highest point in Vancouver, Queen Elizabeth Park for some spectacular city view and the landscapes.
