

## CUBA 7 Days Tour

### Day 1 Arrival Varadero

Meet and greet by our English-speaking tour guide. Private transfer to hotel check in

### Day 2 Varadero - Havana – City Tour (B/L/D)



Today heading to Havana for the tour. Drive along the Malecon to the heart of colonial Havana and walking tour through the beautifully preserved part of this historical city. Old Havana, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1982, is the oldest part of Havana city and the one having the most antiquity. Pass through the streets and squares of Havana's historic center Square of Arms; visit the Rum Museum, Saint Francis Square, Old Square and Cathedral Square

and China town. After lunch we proceed to the Jose Martí Square. This square has been Cuba's revolutionary-political and administrative center since 1959. Tonight, you can choose **optional** Tropicana show where you can enjoy the show from a better spot, closer to the stage.

### Day 3 Havana – Viñales, Pinar del Rio - India Cave - Cigar Factory – Havana (B/L/D)



Today travel to the Province of Pinar del Rio located on the western tip of the island. We journey to Viñales, cultural landscape of mankind and to Vueltabajo, where the world's best tobacco grows. Cuban cigars are widely considered the best cigars in the world. This can be attributed to two factors: the environment and the people's skill. The soil produces very high-quality tobacco leaves and the humidity is ideal for both growing and drying them. The traditional process used today is very similar to the process used for the last few hundred years. In the factory, you can see, unlike other countries, skilled Cuban makes the entire cigar themselves. We continue to navigate by boat through an ancient Indian cave. After the tour we are heading back to

Havana.

### Day 4 Havana – Santa Clara – Trinidad (B/L/D)

Today departure to Santa Clara visit the Mausoleum Che Guevara the resting place for Che and 16 of his men killed in action in 1967 I Bolivia is a memorial complex featuring an large square used for parades and large rallies, a monument now emblematic of Santa Clara, and a mausoleum crypt with an exhibit displaying artifacts, photos and memorabilia of Che, an extensive view of his life and work. We continue departure to Trinidad – the third settlement founded in Cuba in 1514 was declared a World Heritage Site (1988) given its high degree of preservation. The town treasures a socio-cultural and economic history for more than five centuries tour. We will take you to the Valle de los Ingenios (Valley of the Sugar Mills) to see the ruins of dozens of 19 century sugar mills located just outside the city

### **Day 5 Trinidad –Cienfuegos – Varadero (B/L/D)**

Today we journey to the beautiful neighboring Trinidad were declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Climb to the outlook of the well maintained Iznaga Tower. Tiny Trinidad is, quite simply, one of the finest colonial towns in all the Americas. A few square blocks of cobblestone streets, pretty pastel-colored 18th- and 19th-century houses, palaces, and plazas. Afterward, heading to Cienfuegos French settlers from Haiti and Louisiana founded the town in 1819. Explore the city knows as La Perla del Sur (the Southern Pearl), Cienfuegos is an uncharacteristically calm and inviting port city. The historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2005. The beautiful bay and harborfront buildings, the charming wooden homes of Punta Gorda, and the Malecón make it a wonderful city to explore and enjoy. Heading to Playa de Varadero, the largest and one of the most popular beach resorts in Cuba. Its pristine 21 km long white sand beach is considered by many to be one of the most beautiful in the world
