

US Seattle, Portland and San Francisco 8 Days

Highlights: Seattle • Portland • Crater Lake • San Francisco • Humboldt Redwood State Park



Day 1 Arrival Seattle

Meet and Greet by English-speaking tour guide. Seat-in-coach transfer to hotel.

1-Night Hotel accommodation in Seattle: Quality Inn or Comfort Inn or similar

Day 2 Seattle – Portland - Roseburg



Depart towards Portland. The city is known for its parks, bridges and bicycle paths, as well as for its eco-friendliness and its microbreweries and coffeehouses. We visit International Rose Test Garden in Washington Park. There are over

10,000 rose bushes of approximately 650 varieties. We continue towards Pioneer Place filled with shopping, dining and entertainment. Add tax-free shopping, and you're certain to have the time of your life. We also stop by Steel Bridge and Hawthorne Bridge. Transportation to selected hotel in Roseburg for accommodation.

Day 3 Roseburg - Crater Lake National Park – San Francisco



Discover Crater Lake National Park, which is the fifth-oldest national park in the United States and the only national park in Oregon. We will visit Crater Lake which is the main feature of Crater Lake National Park and is famous for its deep blue color and water clarity. The lake partly fills a nearly 655 m deep caldera that was formed around 7,700 years ago by the collapse of the volcano Mount Mazama. Transportation to selected hotel in San Francisco for accommodation.

**If the National Park closes due to bad weather condition, we will visit Lake Shasta Caverns to replace. this series of natural limestone caves reveals an underground world some 250 million years in the making.*

Day 4 San Francisco – City Tour



Full day excursion in San Francisco. You can see the city's most famous landmark: Golden Gate Bridge. It is one the seven wonders of the modern world. We also stop by City Hall, Palace of Art and Fisherman's Wharf. Return to hotel.

Today, you can choose **optional** San Francisco ferry to Angle Island, where the cruise will cross the San Francisco bay, catching up-close views of Alcatraz and the city's monumental bridges. You can also choose **optional** to visit Madame Tussauds Wax Museum

and pose “in with the world’s most iconic musicians, A-list stars, sports legends, world leaders and more.

Day 5 San Francisco - Harvest Moon Winery Tour – Humboldt Redwood State Park – Eureka



We travel to Humboldt Redwood State Park, the world's largest remaining contiguous old-growth forest of coast redwoods. The trees here are thousands of years old and have never been logged. Here you can find the Rockefeller Forest, home of The Rockefeller Tree, a 362' tall and 13'.6" wide giant, Founder's Grove and the fallen Dyerville Giant, and one of the last remaining drive thru redwood trees the Shrine Drive Thru Tree. Transportation to selected hotel in Eureka for accommodation.

Today you can choose **optional** winery farm tour in Harvest Moon Winery where you can learn the process of wine making and have opportunity to try some wine.

Day 6 Eureka – Florence – Eugene



Drive along US Route 101 to Florence. In summer season, you can choose **optional** Giant Dune Buggy tour. Ride the buggy, you will travel across an impressive natural wonder of endless shifting sand. You can also choose **optional** Sea Lion Cave Tour. The area is considered the largest sea cave in the United States where Steller sea lions and their

cubs take shelter each year. Transportation to selected hotel in Eugene for accommodation.

Day 7 Eugene - Columbia River Gorge – Olympia – Seattle

Departure to the Grotto, which is a Catholic outdoor shrine and sanctuary. We continue towards Columbia River Gorge and visit Multnomah Falls, which is the second tallest year-round waterfall in the United States. We also stop by Olympia, the capital of Washington state. You can visit State Capitol Building. Transportation to selected hotel in Seattle for accommodation.

1-Night Hotel accommodation in Seattle: Quality Inn or Red Lion or similar

Day 8 Seattle – City Tour/Departure

Full day excursion in Seattle. The city is surrounded by water, mountains and evergreen forests, and contains thousands of acres of parkland. Visit Pike Market, which is the oldest continuously operating farmers market in the country and one of Seattle's most popular draws. We also stop by the first Starbucks. Snap a picture of the original mermaid logo and pick up Starbucks swag only found at the Pike Place location. Departure from Seattle.

You can choose **optional** to visit Boeing Factory and Air Flight Museum to visit, which is the largest private air and space museum in the world with more than 150 aircraft in its collection. You can choose **optional** to visit Chihuly Glass Garden. The garden provides a look at the inspiration and influences that inform the career of artist Dale Chihuly. You can choose **optional** to visit MoPOP, which is home to exhibits, interactive activity stations, sound sculpture, and various educational resources. You can also choose **optional** to visit Sky View Observatory at Columbia Center, the tallest public viewing area in the Pacific Northwest, where you can enjoy the 360-degree panoramic view includes Mt. Rainier, Bellevue, the Cascade Mountains, Mt. Baker, Elliott Bay, the Olympic Mountains, the Space Needle and the city of Seattle.
