Day 2 New York – City Tour (B)



Today visit main attractions in Manhattan. Here has been described as the cultural, financial, media, and entertainment capital of the world. Day 04 Niagara Fall – Corning Museum of Glass – Washington D.C. (B)

This morning hear the thundering water of Niagara Falls. We continue towards to Corning, where you can choose **optional** visit Corning Museum of Glass.
